

The VNR of Liechtenstein suggests that in certain areas progress has been made but it also suggests that the Liechtenstein Government needs to increase its ambition regarding the SDG agenda.

Thus: what are your primary obstacles in advancing progress towards sustainable development, including the necessary socio-economic transformation that is entailed with it?

Notwithstanding the Liechtenstein commitment, civil society representatives of Liechtenstein would welcome a more distinct mainstreaming of the SDG agenda within the relevant spheres of Government activities.

We have 4 questions:

1. What are the specific initiatives taken to focus on the social groups that are often discriminated against - such as women, older persons, persons with disabilities and LGBTI people, migrants and refugees, among others?
2. What are the specific actions you're undertaking to reduce identified inequality gaps and what is your plan towards 2030 to eradicate all forms of inequality? What are the accessibility measures you have considered for challenges that specific groups of population face?
3. 3) What accountability mechanisms have you put in place in Lichtenstein to progressively guarantee, respect, protect and fulfil all human rights for all?
4. What plans do you have to follow-up the presentation of the VNR at national and subnational levels after the HLPF? What does the cooperation between VNR countries look like when implementing the SDGS?
